Sri Lankans living in the UK and Ireland may submit their applications for a Police Clearance

Certificate to the High Commission to be forwarded to the Inspector General of Police in Sri Lanka.

The duly filled application should be submitted to this High Commission in person with £15/- or if by post with a postal order or bank draft in favour of “ Sri Lanka High Commission – London”, along with a letter stating the reason for requesting the Police Clearance Certificate and copy of Sri Lankan Passport or Sri Lankan National Identity card. For Non Sri Lankans, please submit a copy of their respective passport. Without above mentioned copies, the Sri Lankan Police doesnot process applications.

On submission of the application, it will be forwarded to the Deputy Inspector General of Police (Administration) of the Police Headquarters, Colombo 01, Sri Lanka who would issue the Certificate of Clearance after verifying the details of the applicant from the respective Police Stations.

Upon receipt of the Police Clearance Certificate, it will be sent to the applicant by post or it can be collected from the Consular Division of the High Commission.
